

Staying Safe at UK University Search Events

Liverpool Anfield Thursday 18th November

Procedures in place due to Covid-19

UK University Search are committed to ensuring your school/college's visit to the event is as informative and enjoyable as possible. Students, teachers, staff and parents will need to follow the following rules before and during the event.

The procedures may be subject to change in the lead up to and directly before the event takes place. UK University Search will ensure all government laws and quidance in relation to Covid-19 are adhered to.

Testing and Vaccinations of Attendees

- 1. **Students** We strongly recommend that students conduct a lateral flow test the evening before or on the morning of the event. Please advise students to do this. Any person with a positive result should not attend the event.
- Teachers, Staff, Parents All adults (above age of 18) must either be double vaccinated or complete a Covid-19 test the evening before or morning of the event. You will need to bring proof of this to the event. Proof of double vaccination will need to be shown using the NHS app (this is not the Covid-19 track and trace app) this can be downloaded and set up on your smartphone using the following link - www.nhs.uk/nhs-app

A Lateral Flow test is acceptable if an adult has not received both vaccinations. You will need to show you have tested negative by either creating an Event Pass on the NHS app (which can be done here - www.nhs.uk/nhs-app. Alternatively, you can record your result here www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result and show the text message you have received as proof of your negative result.

You should **NOT** attend the event if:

- Tested positive in the last 10 days
- Feeling unwell / have been experiencing any COVID symptoms in the last 10 days, unless they
 have had a NHS PCR Test which has come back negative and they have had no additional
 symptoms since
- Must self isolate following latest government guidance

Before the Event

- 1. All students, teachers and staff must be <u>registered online</u> at least 2 days before the event in order to receive their ticket. UK University Search need to adhere strictly to permitted numbers within the exhibition area. All visitors must show their ticket to gain entry, we advise that where possible this is displayed on a smartphone, however printed tickets are also acceptable.
- 2. Teachers and staff responsible must have agreed arrival and leaving times with their UK University Search rep. School groups will have a maximum of 1.5 hours at the event.

At the event

- 1. We **strongly urge** students and staff to continue to wear face coverings when indoors at the event, particularly whilst moving around.
- 2. Time within the venue will be strictly limited to 1.5 hours.
- 3. Tickets must be ready to be presented at the entrance to be scanned. These can be printed on paper or displayed on a smartphone.
- 4. Seminars will have limited capacity due to social distancing.
- 5. Hand sanitizers will be available throughout the event.
