

Staying Safe at UK University Search Events

Cardiff City Stadium Wednesday 13th October

Procedures in place due to Covid-19

UK University Search are committed to ensuring your school/college's visit to the event is as informative and enjoyable as possible. Students, teachers, staff and parents will need to follow the following rules before and during the event.

The procedures may be subject to change in the lead up to and directly before the event takes place. UK University Search will ensure all government laws and guidance in relation to Covid-19 are adhered to.

Testing and Vaccinations of Attendees

1. **Students** - If students are **over the age of 18** they will need to present a Covid Pass to gain entry, this can either show proof of a negative Covid-19 test or proof of double vaccination. If you are unable to generate a Covid Pass, email or text message lateral flow results confirmation will be accepted. Please see here for more information: <https://gov.wales/get-your-nhs-covid-pass>
2. We strongly recommend that students **under 18** also conduct a lateral flow test the evening before or on the morning of the event. Please advise students to do this. Any person with a positive result should not attend the event.
3. **Teachers, Staff, Parents** – All adults (above age of 18) must either be double vaccinated or complete a Covid-19 test the evening before or morning of the event. You will need to bring proof of this to the event. If you are unable to generate a Covid Pass, email or text message lateral flow results confirmation will be accepted. Before the Event

1. All students, teachers and staff must be [registered online](#) **at least 2 days before** the event in order to receive their ticket. UK University Search need to adhere strictly to permitted numbers within the exhibition area. All visitors must show their ticket to gain entry, we advise that where possible this is displayed on a smartphone, however printed tickets are also acceptable.
2. Teachers and staff responsible must have agreed arrival and leaving times with their UK University Search rep. School groups will have a maximum of 2 hours at the event.

At the event

1. Face masks must be worn **at all times** inside of the venue unless the attendee is exempt.
2. Time within the venue will be strictly limited to 2 hours.
3. Tickets must be ready to be presented at the entrance to be scanned. These can be printed on paper or displayed on a smartphone.
4. Seminars will have limited capacity due to social distancing.
5. Hand sanitizers will be available throughout the event.
