Dedicated Rep

NEW Event App

Students can use the new UKUniApp to get their ticket/QR code. This can be scanned by exhibitors they are interested in receiving further information from. We will also provide students and teachers with any important updates throughout the day.

The app features vital info for students, parents, teachers and staff. This includes access to the official interactive digital brochure. Just in case students miss any, they can also watch video versions of each of the day's main seminars/talks. UKUniApp enables students to see all the exhibitors attending, find your way around the event, check your UCAS score and browse our open days calendar.
